The Melrose Y is looking for someone who is passionate about swimming and wants to partner with an ever-growing community. During swim season, this position will work afternoons & evenings and during weekends for swim meets.

Essential Functions:

- 1. Supervises aquatic program activities to meet YMCA objectives. Ensure program quality and monitor staff performance and member service.
- 2. Assist management team with monitoring daily pool operations to adhere to state to all state, local, and YMCA health and safety regulations.
- 3. Develop relationships with members and obtain regular feedback on programs.
- 4. Supervise pool area and help ensure lifeguard staff are monitoring patrons and portraying professional behavior at all times. Ability to fill in as lifeguard, water safety instructor, and aquatics instructor.
- 5. Monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of and participation in programs.
- 6. Help maintain pool logs, pool updates, and incident reports.
- 7. Assist with aquatics program/lesson scheduling, responding to daily public inquiries about Aquatics Department and other regular administrative tasks.
- 8. Hire, train and supervise all coaching staff and manages coaching payroll.
- 9. Ensures records of coaching staff certifications are up-to-date and complete.
- 10. Set Practice schedules & group levels and weekly team workouts.
- 11. Plan and coordinate seasonal tryout, team cuts and work with final rosters.
- 12. Determines meet schedule for team & oversee individual and team entries
- 13. Attends highest level of competition and sees that all swim meets are attended by a team coach
- 14. Oversees communication: web site, newsletters, meet information, publicity, and team records.
- 15. Working with the Swim Team Parents Organization and board to promote and support the swim team.
- 16. Monitors team budget, assists in fundraising and oversees the purchasing of equipment needed for swim team.
- 17. Build effective, authentic relationships with community partners, sponsors, parents and program participants.
- 18. Assist in YMCA fund raising activities and special events as assigned.
- 19. Completes other related duties as assigned by Aquatics Director.
