We are looking forward to having everyone attend our competition! I know we are going to have some great swimming. The Bluefish community has worked very hard to put together a great meet! We hope New Englanders will give a warm welcome to Swimming World Tv and their Producer/Reporter Garrett McCaffrey. Please have your family friends log on to watch the Swimming Word Coverage! PLEASE pass this information on to your team. Changes from original meet information Athletes may not bring their own chairs onto the pool deck, seating will be provided. Warm-up Schedule attached! Coach's scratches ahead of time would be greatly appreciated. We will have a coaches meeting on Saturday morning at 7:50am.

Bluefish have decided to offer *Continuous warm-up warm-down in one lane during the Friday evening* 500FR's, Pre-lims and Finals on Saturday and the Open session on Sunday morning. Warm-Up Warm-Down lanes will be sectioned off from the competition lanes with an additional lane line. 12 under 200IM Friday, 12 under afternoon middle session and Sunday 12 under session will all be run with 8 lanes of competition. With the addition of warm-up, warm-down lane only 7 lanes of competition are available for Finals so we have decided to expand the "Final" opportunity so that the 13&Over age groups the top 21 swimmers will advance to swim in 3 heats, a "C", "B"and "A" Championships Final. 11-12 age group swimmers will remain 1 heat so top 7 advances to swim "A" Championship Final. Athletes names will be announced while they are swimming for the "C" and "B" Finals and the "A" Final names will be read with athletes behind the blocks. No ready room and no marching out to allow for the time for the additional heats.

Remember we are a guest in the Attleboro High School please be respectful. The High School is hosting a dance Friday evening starting at 7pm. Walk to the pool, past garage door with the number 7 painted on it; left along side the building away from the parking lot towards the football field; Entrance to the pool is around the front of building.)

We have also ordered medals to be awarded to the trials/finals session for top 3 finishers for all age groups. All other 12 under events will be awarded ribbons 1-8 place. Coaches please remember to pick up your awards on Sunday before you leave.
